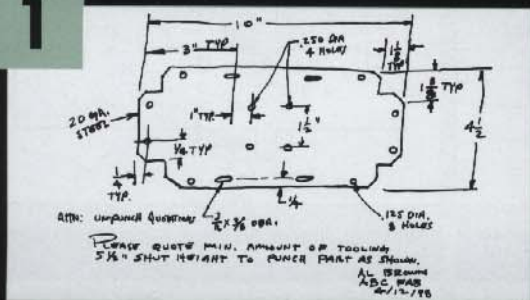


Mounting: The Basics

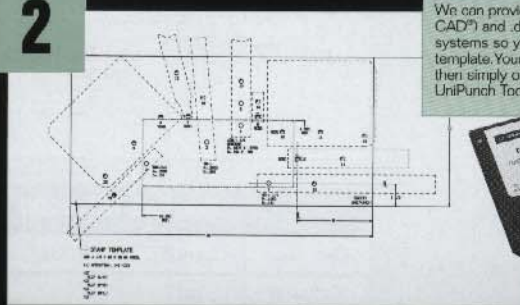
This overview is designed to demonstrate the basic principles common to the five different UniPunch Mounting Systems.

Start by sending us a sketch or prototype part.

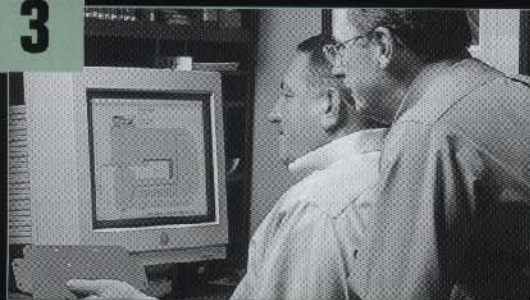

TEMPLATE LAYOUT MASTER DISK

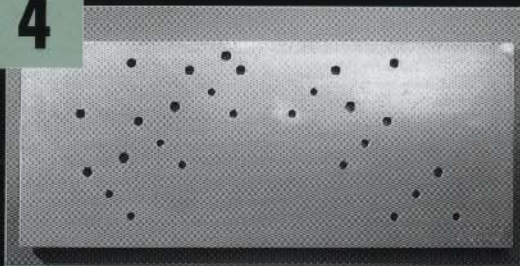

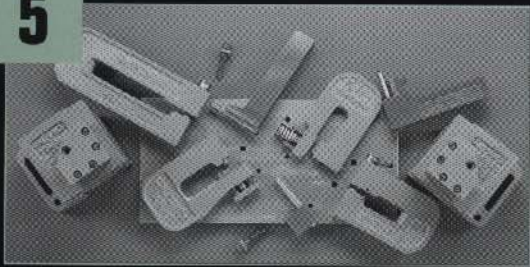
Our Technical Support team will recommend proper tooling based on your amount and part requirements.

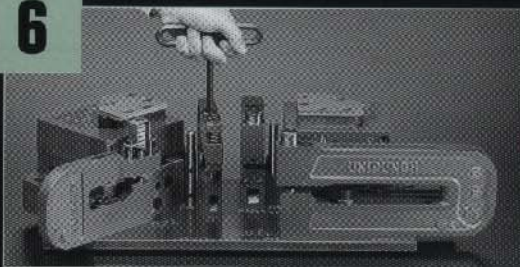
We supply the appropriate template to mount and position tooling and gages.

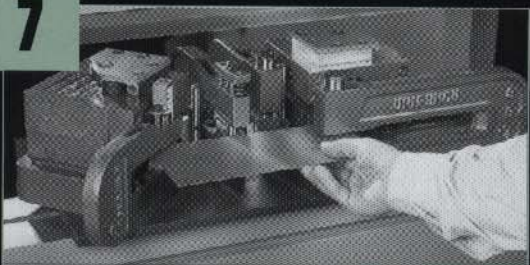
We supply the template and tooling as a complete system.

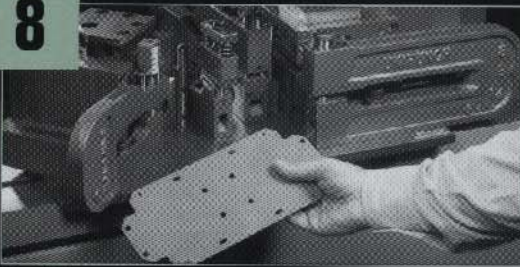
Tooling is assembled on the template outside the press.
